ALL PROGRAMS INCLUDE:

- ❖ Greeting at Granada airport / bus station (provided the student arrives on the official date of arrival).
- ❖ Homestay: 3 meals per day (breakfast, lunch and dinner), laundry once a week, Wi-Fi.
- ❖ Enrolment and registration fees at the University of Granada's Center of Languages.
- ❖ Official transcript issued by the University of Granada.
- ❖ Onsite assistance.
- ❖ 1 and 2 month programs: Weekend trip to Seville and Cordoba (July program includes 2 day trips instead).
- ❖ Guided tours of: Cathedral and Royal Chapel, Albaicín old Arab district, Alhambra.

ACADEMIC PROGRAM**	OPTION I-A: One month <u>CILE</u> (Intensive Language) 80 hours	Intensive Spanish Language Course (CILE, 80 hours) ▶ This course is taught at 9 different levels. ▶ It combines Spanish language and grammar according to the syllabus for each level. ▶ 4 hours of Spanish language classes per day (80 contact hours in total)
	OPTION I-B: One month <u>CILYC</u> (Intensive Language & Culture) 90 hours Minimum level required: Intermediate Spanish skills	Intensive Spanish Language and Culture Course (CILYC, 90 hours) This course combines language with culture classes. It is only available for students with intermediate or above Spanish skills . The student must choose 90 hours among the following subjects: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Spanish Language (45 hours) 2. Latin American Literature (22.5 hours) 3. Spanish Literature (22.5 hours) 4. Spanish Geography (22.5 hours) 5. Spanish History (22.5 hours) 6. History of Art in Spain (22.5 hours) 7. Spanish Civilization and Culture (22.5 hours) 8. Islamic Culture in Spain (22.5 hours) 9. Latin American Civilization and Culture (22.5 hours) 10. The diversity of Spanish in the World (22.5 hours) 11. An introduction to Business Spanish (22.5 hours) *Some of these classes may take place in the evenings.
	OPTION I-C (One month) <u>CILE + extra class</u> 102.50 hours Minimum level required: Intermediate Spanish skills	This option combines the Intensive Spanish Language Course (CILE, 80 hours) with a 22.5 hour class that can be Spanish Civilization & Culture OR Conversation Practice
	OPTION II-A (Two months) INTENSIVE LANGUAGE	Includes the CILE (Language) course both in June and July
	OPTION II-B (Two months) INTENSIVE LANGUAGE & CULTURE	Includes the CILE (Language) course in June and the CILYC (Language & Culture) course in July
