- 1 and 2 months programs: Weekend trip to Seville and Cordoba (July program includes 2 day trips instead).
- Guided tours: Cathedral and Royal Chapel, Albaicín (old Arab district), Alhambra.

	OPTION II-B (Two months) CILE + CILYC (Intensive Lang. & Culture) - 170 hours	It includes the CILE (Intensive Language) course in June + the CILYC (Language & Culture) course in July
